Dani Cañigueral Viñals holds a Bachelor's degree in Primary Education from the University of Girona. He has worked in several public schools, and since 1989 he has been working as a Primary teacher at the Montessori Palau Girona.

For the last 15 years he has been a Montessori teacher certified by the Association Montessori Internationale (AMI).

He has been responsible for coordination and has assumed functions related to pedagogical innovation in his school. He has the AMI diploma for Early Childhood Education (3-6) and Elementary Education (6-12). He is an international trainer of AMI guides in Elementary Education. He is currently enrolled in inclusive education credits at the University and is preparing to do a Doctorate in education.
